

Covid 19 update – 25th August 2020

The Committee is pleased to inform you that the clubhouse is being opened up again for careful use as of Friday 28th August. Social distancing requirements still apply including the use of masks as and when necessary.

Track and Trace logging is still required, either by the paper or electronic system. This is not mandatory but very sensible in case we do have an issue with a club member contracting the virus.

Please note that although the clubhouse is being opened up visitors are still restricted to club members and their household bubbles.

The caged area has been removed and all three sets of toilets will be in use. However only one cubicle in each of the ladies and gents toilets will be available and the showers will remain out of use at present. To maintain social distancing only one person is allowed in the toilet at a time and please sanitise any necessary areas before and after use.

The tables have been laid out with four chairs per table maximum and the need for social distancing still needs to be observed, especially when walking through the clubhouse. The spare chairs have been taped off and should not be used. There is sanitising liquid available throughout the clubhouse for members to use to clean the tables and chairs as needed.

The kitchen area will be open for hot drinks, canned drinks and some snacks only. There is no food preparation of any kind at the moment. Please bring your own cups or wash ours carefully before and after use. Make sure that you wash your hands or gel them frequently. Only one person at a time to be allowed in the kitchen and once again social distancing needs to be observed. It would be really helpful if you could take any rubbish away with you please.

There are two banquet style tables by the front door for the taxi driver and Office of the Day to use along with the necessary equipment to run the water taxi. Please do not touch any of this equipment unless covering the duties.

Professional cleaners will clean all three toilets, wipe down the kitchen surfaces and do the floor each Monday and Thursday.

There will be additional signage on the tables, by the kitchen and on the toilet doors to remind club members of the need to maintain social distancing, the need for sanitising and frequent hand washing etc.

If we all play our part in maintaining the hygiene standards and observing the social distancing rules the clubhouse should be a safe environment for members to use.
